

<p><b>Name the planet closest to the sun.</b></p> <p><b>Mercury</b></p>	<p><b>Name the hottest planet.</b></p> <p><b>Venus is about 900°F!</b></p>	<p><b>What 2 planets rotate opposite of all the others?</b></p> <p><b>Venus and Uranus (so does dwarf planet Pluto)</b></p>
<p><b>Which is longer on Venus – a day or a year?</b></p> <p><b>A day! A day on Venus is 243 Earth days. A year on Venus is only 225 Earth days.</b></p>	<p><b>Why does the Earth have seasons?</b></p> <p><b>The Earth's seasons are due to the tilt of its axis of rotation.</b></p>	<p><b>Which planet is known as the “Red Planet?”</b></p> <p><b>Mars</b></p>
<p><b>Which planet spins the fastest?</b></p> <p><b>Jupiter</b> <b>A day on Jupiter is only 10 hours long.</b></p>	<p><b>Which planets have rings?</b></p> <p><b>All of the gas giants – Jupiter, Saturn, Uranus, and Neptune</b></p>	<p><b>What are Saturn's rings mostly made of?</b></p> <p><b>Mostly ice; also some rock.</b></p>
<p><b>Which planet is tilted on its side?</b></p> <p><b>Uranus</b></p>	<p><b>Which planet takes the longest to travel around the Sun?</b></p> <p><b>Neptune</b></p>	<p><b>Name the largest planet.</b></p> <p><b>Jupiter</b></p>
<p><b>Name the smallest planet.</b></p> <p><b>Mercury</b></p>	<p><b>Which planet has a day about as long as a day on Earth?</b></p> <p><b>Mars</b></p>	<p><b>Name 3 dwarf planets.</b></p> <p><b>Pluto, Eris, Ceres, Makemake, and Haumea (Sometimes Pluto's largest moon, Charon, is called a planet, too. Pluto and Charon seem to orbit around each other.)</b></p>
